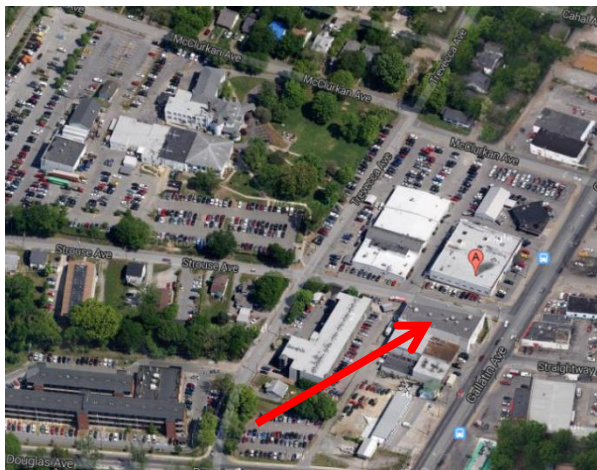
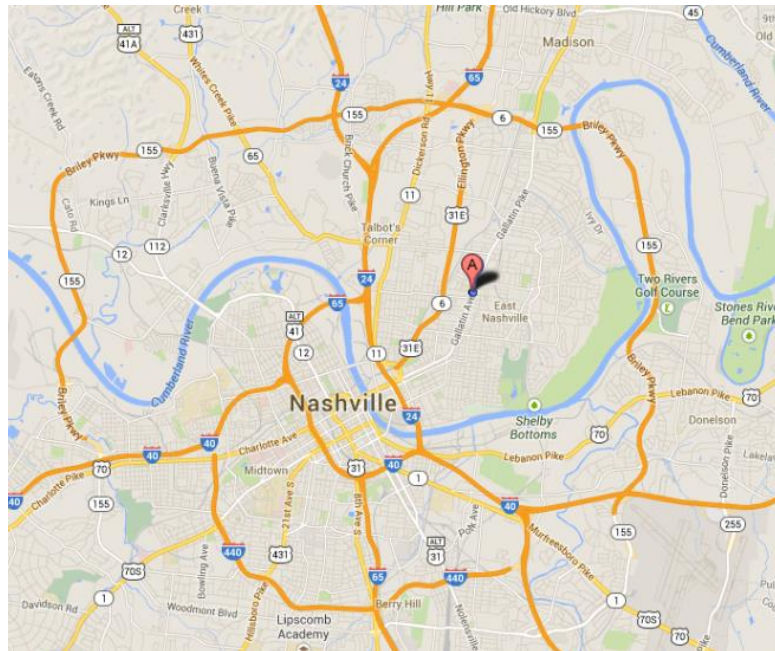

Take I-24 W and take exit 47A for US-31E N/E Spring St. Merger onto Spring St which then merges into Ellington Parkway. Take the Douglas Ave exit. Turn right on Douglas Ave. Turn left onto Gallatin Rd. Training center will be on the left.

From the North using I-24

Take exit 87 toward **US-431/Trinity Ln.** Turn left onto **Brick Church Pike.** Turn left onto **W Trinity Ln.** Slight left onto **E Trinity Ln.** Turn right onto **Gallatin Pike**
