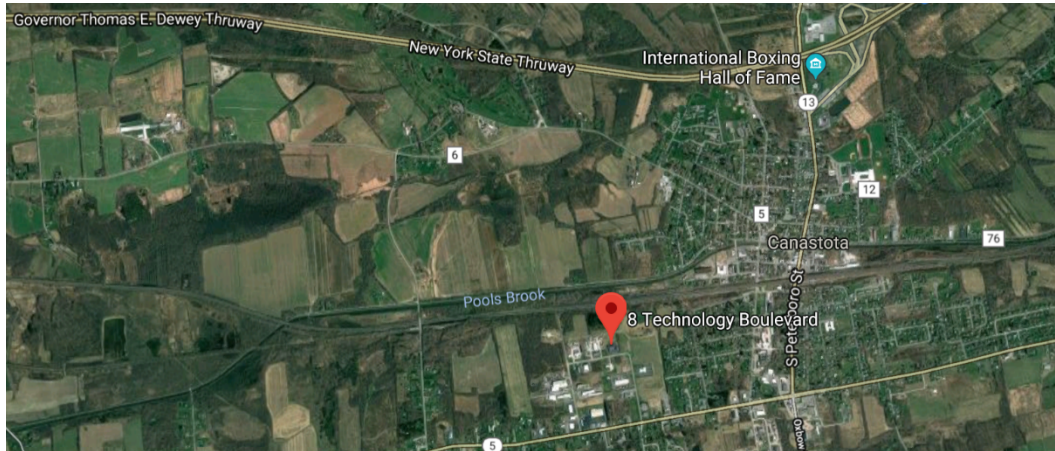

From Scranton, PA: Take I-81 North toward Syracuse, NY. Exit 16A to travel I-481 North. Take exit 3E to travel NY-5 east. Turn left and go north on Dominic Bruno Blvd. Turn right onto Technology Blvd.
