



## From The South

Take the ramp onto I-95 N. Keep right to continue on FL-10 W, follow signs for Prudential Dr/Main St/Riverside Ave/Mary St. Take the Main Street Bridge exit toward Prudential Drive/Ocean Street. Merge onto FL-10 W Continue onto U.S. 1 N. Turn left onto E State St. Destination will be on the right

## From West

Merge onto I-10 E via the ramp to Jacksonville. Continue onto U.S 17 N. Merge onto I-95 N. Take exit 353B toward Union St/Beaver St. Merge onto U.S 17 N. Turn left onto N Pearl St. Turn left onto W State St. Destination will be on the right

## From the North:

Take I-95 S toward Jacksonville. After entering Florid, take exit **353B** on the left to merge onto **W Union St**. Turn left onto **N Pearl St.** Turn left onto **W State St.** Destination will be on the right.

#### Instructions:

The school has ample parking. Park in student parking and come to the automotive classrooms. The Hunter instructor will issue you a parking pass if needed.
