DESCRIPTION

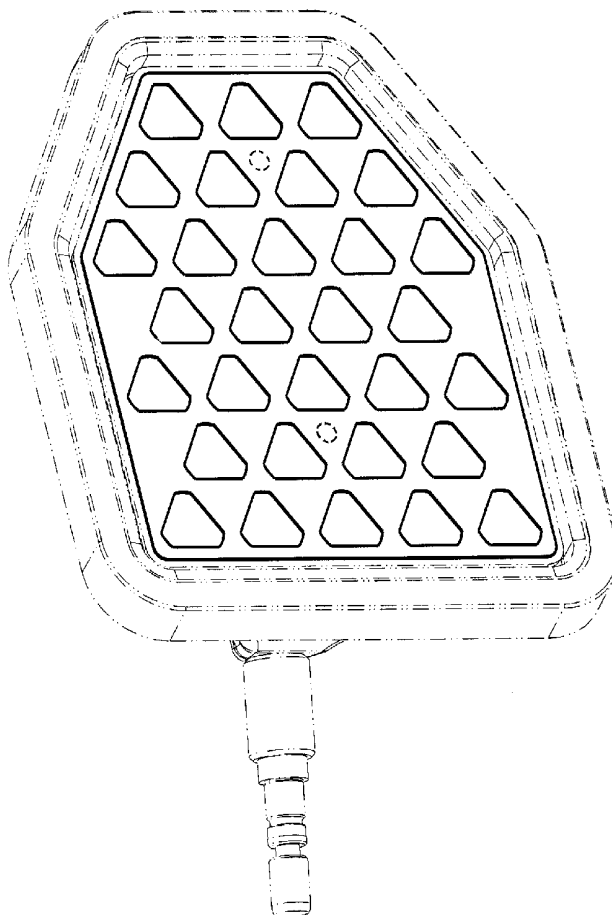
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the alignment target apparatus of our new design.

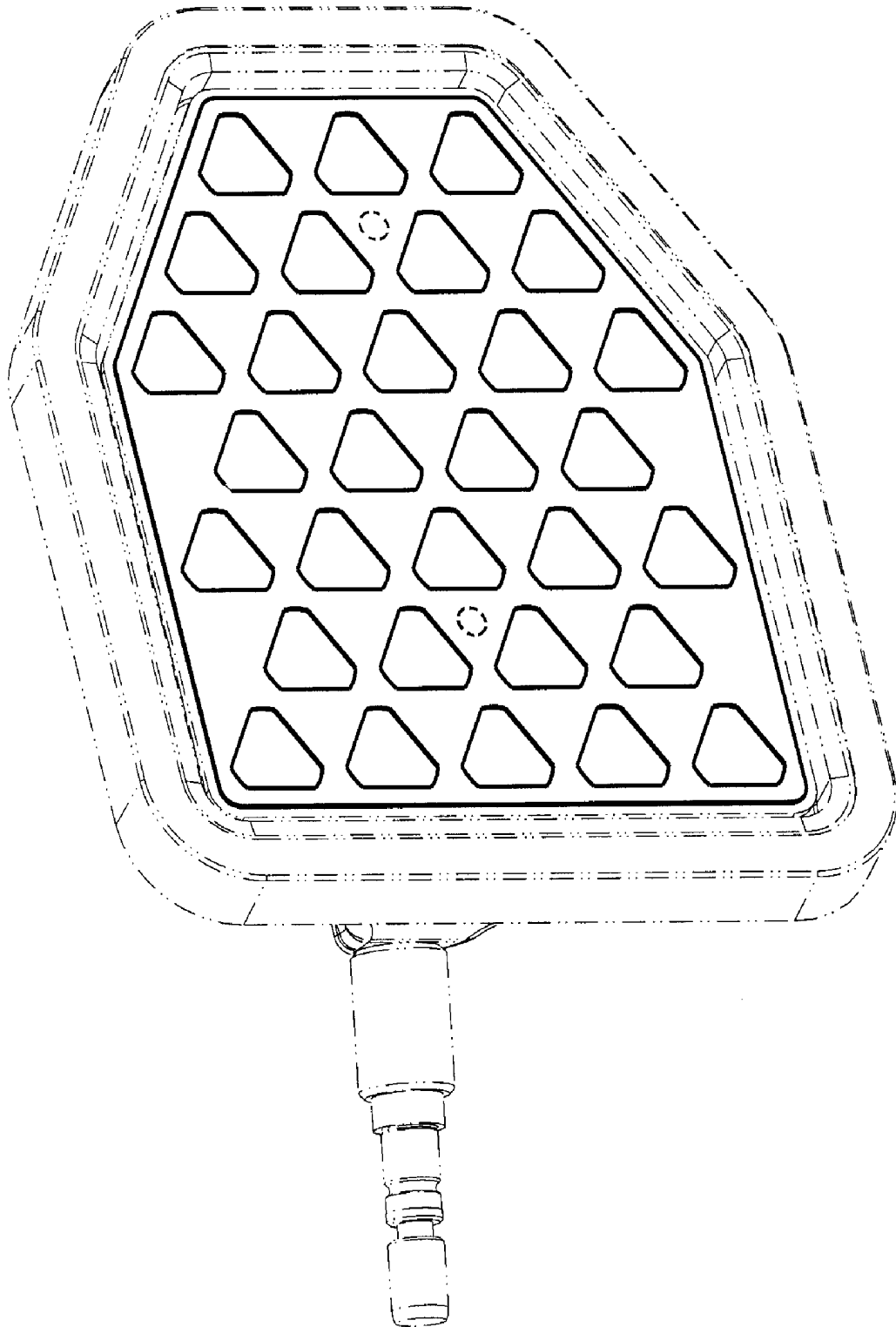

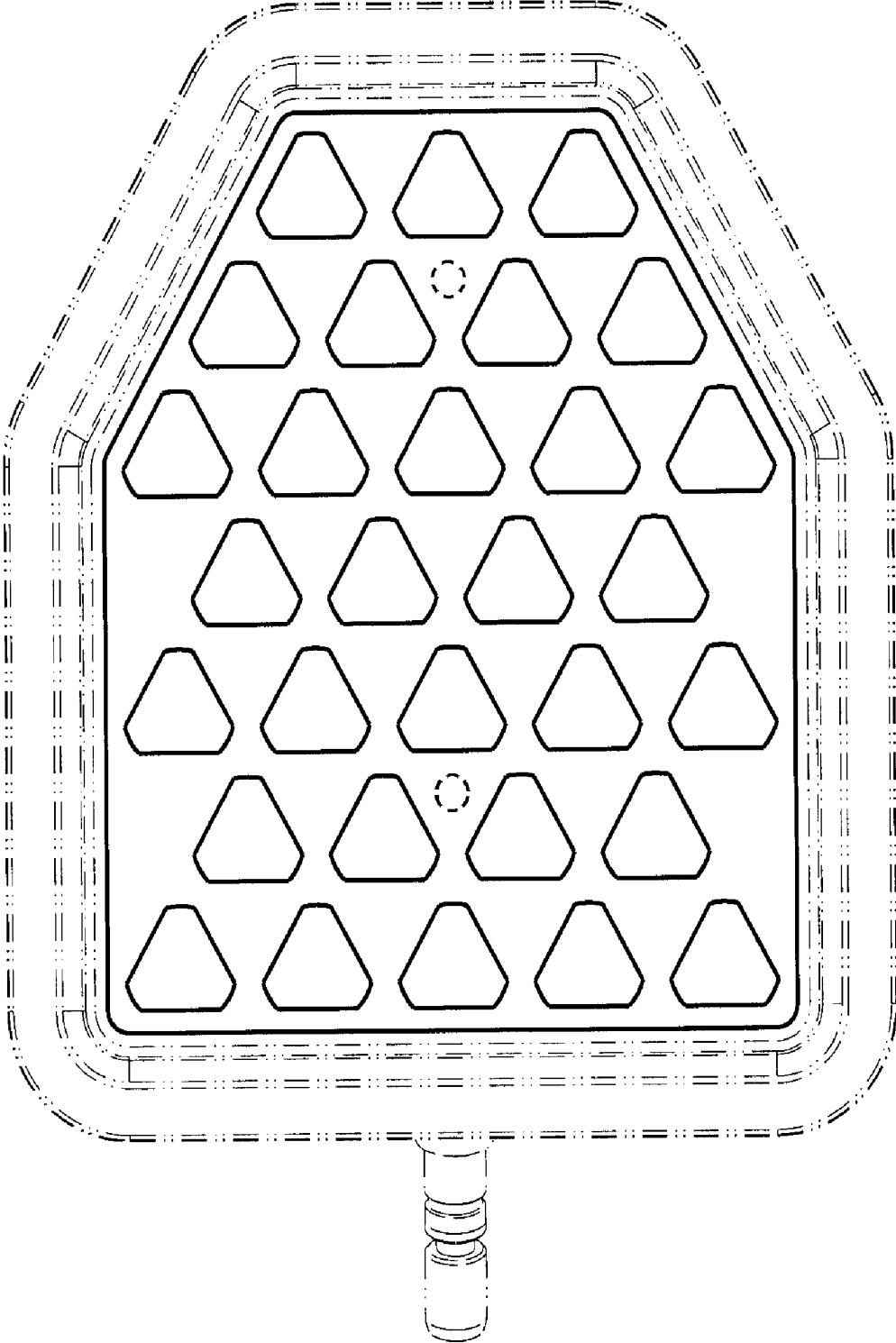

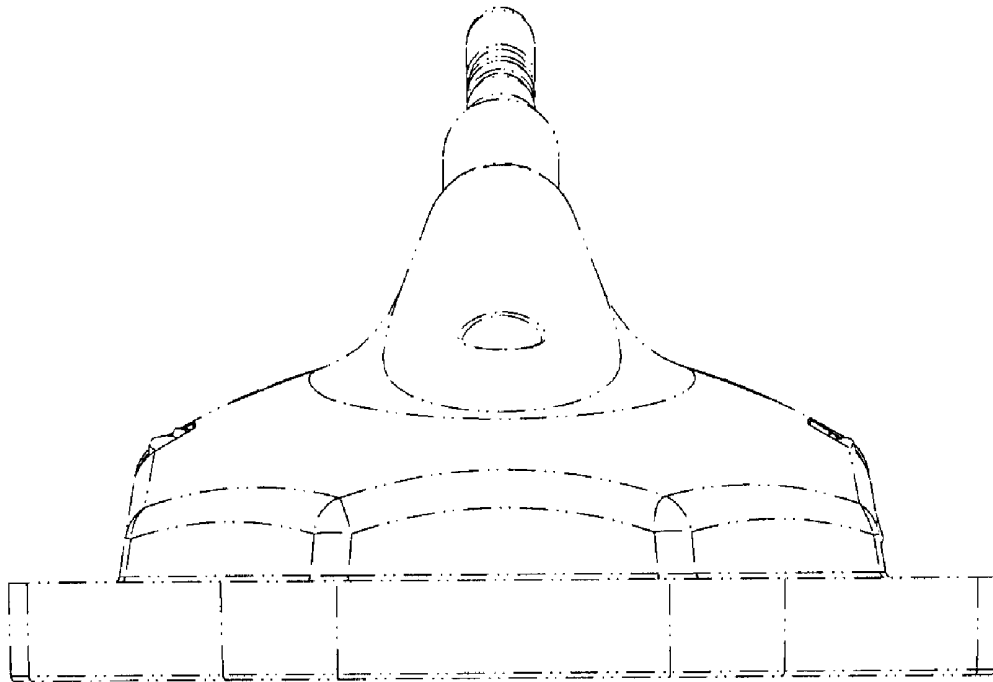
